OVERVIEW

Sandy focuses her practice on complex civil litigation, toxic tort litigation and products liability litigation. Immediately after law school, Sandy served as an Americorp Attorney with the non-profit Health Law Advocates, where she had the opportunity to represent clients in both public and private health care coverage denials, including appearing before the Medicaid Board of Hearings to challenge appeal denials of healthcare coverage. During her last year of law school, Sandy served as a Student Attorney representing clients in the probate and family courts, assisting them with obtaining guardianship appointments and arguing denials of Social Security Disability Benefits and healthcare coverage denials by insurers. In addition, Sandy worked on personal injury matters as a law clerk for a personal injury firm in Massachusetts, focusing on traumatic brain injuries.
